PRODUCTION COMPANY

STAGE SCHOOL

Face Academy provides intensive, audition-only training to skilled performers aged 10 to 25. Face Academy students perform in our major, professional-standard annual musical, as well as at smaller public events and showcases throughout the year. Face Dance, Face Drama, and Face Voice are additional programmes for dancers, actors and singers looking to hone specific skills in those areas outside of Face Academy's musical theatre training.
